SAVE YOUR CHALK..

Keep all pieces in the boxes given to your church, and return unused pieces to us at the stage area (BB&T)... for next year?

TITLE

We saved 1 or 2 squares at the start of your book for the title. Please write it large and pretty for keepsake photographs.

HOLD YOUR CHALK..

firmly at the end, or it will break very easily. Don't bear down too hard. Change colors often if you like, or not.

NOT ENOUGH ROOM?

No problem. Find room on another square, or leave a few words out - we're not going for a world record, here, but just spreading the Word as best we can.

GONE SO SOON?

We want to present The New Testament in its most beautiful way, and don't want to see it deteriorate over several days. So we will be out late this afternoon with water and brooms to remove our creation.

CRACKS & ROUGH?

Some areas of sidewalk are rough, cracked or broken, and we tried to account for this when portioning your words.

NEED EXTRA HANDS?

Just ask! Simply give one of these sheets and chalk to passersby and let them join in the fun! Finished? *Feel free to help other churches!* How many words can you write today? Save your sheets!

IF YOUR SIDEWALK SQUARE IS TOO WIDE,

You may want to (lightly) draw a line down the middle and make it two (or more) columns. This will make it easier for you to write, and easier to read!

Don't worry, just cross it out and keep writing!

SEE THAT PRINTED LABEL...

in a corner of your square? Peel it off and take it with you so we don't leave any litter.
